Formation of Teams: Teams are being formed from evaluated players to ensure the overall quality and matching of individual and team skills in order to form a team that can compete effectively. Every effort is made to place an interested player on their existing team and/or one that they can personally grow and benefit from best. The number of players that evaluate in each age group will determine the number of teams that can be adequately assembled. Be aware that if there aren't enough players to form a team in a particular age group, every effort will be made to place players onto a competitive team in accordance with I.Y.S.A. rules. If a Competitive team cannot be formed or a player is ineligible to be placed onto a team due to I.Y.S.A. rules, players will be able to register for an age appropriate recreational plus team. Competitive is a year commitment.

Refund Policy: - There is a no refund policy once you accept a spot on an Arsenal United Competitive team.

Practices & Season Schedule: - Determined by age group and coach.

Scheduling – All regular season games are determined and scheduled by I.Y.S.A.

Fall Season – Games usually start the weekend following Labor Day and continue through October with the possibility of going into November.

Spring Season – Games usually start in early March and continue through May.

Indoor Season – Your team may elect to participate in Indoor soccer. Indoor sessions can encompass any dates in between the Fall and Spring seasons.

Tournaments – Your team may elect to participate in any number of tournaments. Tournaments are held throughout the year and typically encompass an entire weekend of play (Friday, Saturday and Sunday).

Games - Games are typically held on Saturdays, but may include Wednesday evening or other weekday evenings and can be held throughout I.Y.S.A.'s District 3 region which encompasses southwestern Idaho and may include parts of eastern Oregon.

Practices – Coaches typically start practicing 4 to 5 weeks prior to the first game of each season. Therefore, a coach should contact you about 6 weeks prior to the first game. The coach determines the time and place of practice. Practices are generally held in the evening between 5:00 and 9:00 P.M. either at a local park, school or other authorized location.

Uniforms - Please be sure to wear the correct uniform for each game. (Home or away jersey, team colored shorts, shin guards covered by team colored socks.)

Shin Guards Required- Soft padding (tubing all the way around legs) *Or* hard plastic covered with socks.

Ball - All players are required to bring a ball to practices. The recommended ball sizes are:

1. Size #4 – U10 through U12 (25" – 26" circumference)
2. Size #5 - U13 and up (27" – 28" circumference)

Shoes - Soccer shoes or cleats are **REQUIRED**. Soccer shoes should have plastic or molded rubber studs. The studs must be no more than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch long and should be manufactured and sold as soccer shoes or cleats. The studs must not be sharp (e.g. baseball cleats) nor have a single stud at the toe (e.g. American football shoes) as they are illegal and dangerous. **Please Note** - Nothing dangerous can be worn during a game. Including but not limited to are: jewelry, earrings (including pierced), rings, necklaces, bracelets, watches, hair clips and brimmed hats.
